1) Workshop in collaboration with Ayurvedic College Co-ordinated by Dr. S. C. Burli on 02/07/2025



Ashokrao Mane College of Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon, in collaboration with Ashokrao Mane Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital, organized a One-Day Workshop on “Empowering Research Through Pharmaceutical Techniques and Tools in Ayurveda and Pharmacy” on 2nd July 2025. The workshop aimed to enhance practical and research-oriented skills among UG BAMS students, with more than 60 participants

attending. PG students from all the departments conducted hands-on demonstrations and interactive sessions. The Pharmacology lab session included animal handling techniques and demonstrations of instruments such as Rota-Rod, Eddy’s Hot Plate in accordance with CCSEA guidelines. The Pharmaceutics lab showcased formulation development equipment including tablet compression and dissolution testing apparatus. The Quality Assurance lab emphasized GMP practices, hardness and friability testing, and UV analysis. In Pharmacognosy, students observed crude drug identification, microscopy, and phytochemical screening techniques. The workshop provided valuable interdisciplinary exposure and strengthened the integration of Ayurveda with modern pharmaceutical sciences. 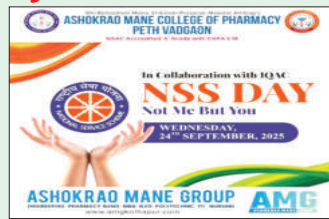
13) Guest Lecture Co-ordinated by Dr. S. C. Burli on 23/09/2025

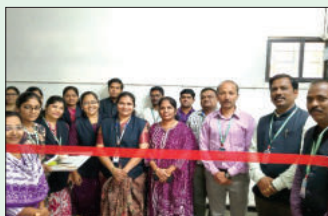
15) World Pharmacists Day Co-ordinated by Mr. P. V. Chavan on 25/09/2025

The objective of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure to the manufacturing processes of Ayurvedic medicines. Students gained insight into the company's strong commitment to quality, authenticity, and timely patient care. The manufacturing unit, spread over

approximately 10,000 sq. ft., integrates classical Ayurvedic principles with modern technology. Detailed explanations were provided on the proper storage, handling, and labelling of raw crude drugs. Traditional Ayurvedic preparations such as Churna, Bhasma, Kadha, Taila, and Rasayanas were demonstrated. The Quality Control Department and various analytical instruments were introduced to the students. They also observed advanced packaging and labelling facilities. Information about Research and Development activities and CTRI-registered clinical trials was shared. The visit effectively bridged the gap between theoretical knowledge and industrial practice. Overall, the industry visit was highly informative, educational, and beneficial for the students.

Lupin receives European Commission approval for biosimilar ranibizumab Ranluspec™ Global pharma major Lupin has announced that it has received approval from the European Commission for its biosimilar ranibizumab, Ranluspec™, for vials and pre-filled syringes. The approval follows a positive opinion from the Committee for Medicinal Products for Human Use. Ranibizumab is a recombinant humanised IgG1 monoclonal antibody fragment that binds and inhibits vascular endothelial growth factor A. 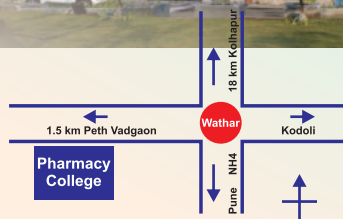
