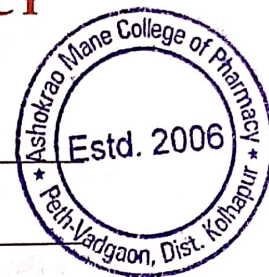

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Student Mentoring System

- Enhance students' self-esteem and confidence.
- Encourage students to establish frequent communication with their academic advisors.
- Offer unwavering support, encouragement, and a positive perspective.
- Guide students to leverage the resources available on campus.

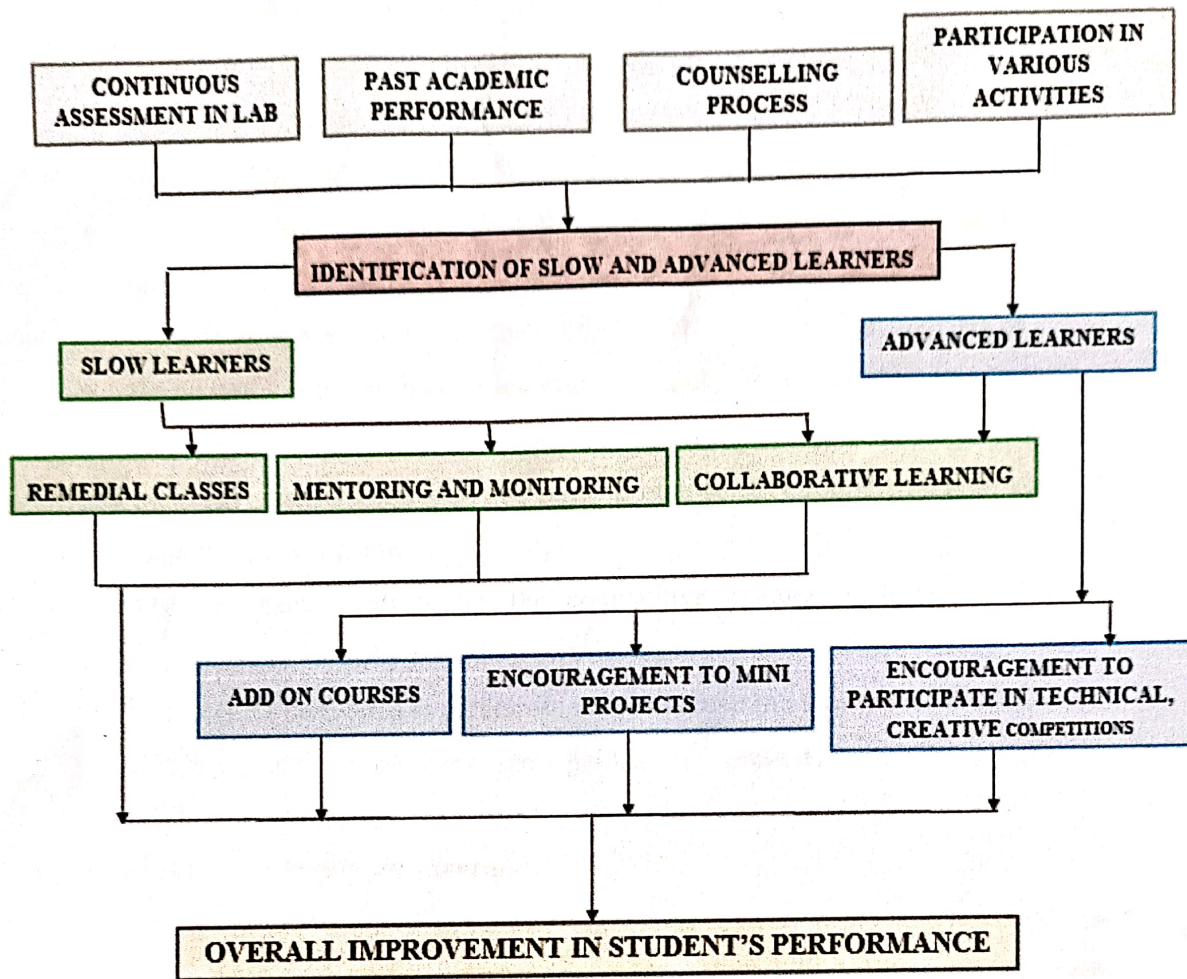
❖ **Parameters for Effective Mentoring:**

- Offer coaching and guidance for competitive examinations.
- Provide information about university rules, regulations, and procedures.
- Guide students towards the right path in their academic and personal lives, and issue warnings if they are veering off course, with proactive communication with parents if necessary.
- Address and assist students in overcoming personal learning challenges.
- Offer advice on soft skills development.
- Foster holistic personality development in students.
- Ensure that students have the freedom to approach any faculty member, mentor, or Head of Department for academic or personal guidance.
- Requiring each student to complete and maintain a mentoring form, providing details of parents/guardians, addresses, contact numbers, and the opportunity to discuss any personal difficulties they may encounter.

POLICY DOCUMENTS FOR SLOW AND ADVANCED LEARNERS



➤ Mechanism to identify advanced learner

- Advanced Learner can be identified based on the performance in University examination of previous semester & internal examination organized by the University/Institute. Those scoring marks more than 70% are categorized into advanced from the feedback from mentors.
- Mentor teacher will prepare a list of advanced learner by analyzing marks in result analysis format.

➤ Special activities organized for advanced learner

- Bright and intelligent students are motivated and inspired to get university ranks.
- Institute motivates to guide these students to take part in the technical events and career orientation workshops and seminar quiz competition, poster presentations, seminar and conferences.
- Motivate these students for the competitive examination/GPAT University rankers are honored by providing certificate.
- Students are motivated to participate in special research projects under IIC.
- Guiding and encouraging to publish / present research papers in conferences/Journals.

➤ Mechanism to identify slow learner


- The students are identified based on their performance in the previous internal/ Semester examination. Those scoring marks below 50% are grouped into slow learner category.
- The slow learner also can be identified on the basis of their routine laboratory work, viva and regular performance.
- Individual subject teacher will prepare a list of slow learners

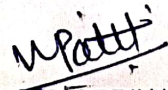
➤ Special activities organized for slow learner

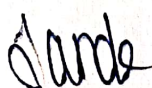
- Remedial classes conducted for Slow Learners.

- Special Counseling (mentoring) is given to slow learners

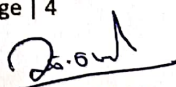
Note: Students are given repeated practice on important questions.
