It belongs to Desh or Paschim Maharashtra region. It belongs to Pune Division. It is located 17 KM towards North from District head quarters Kolhapur. 18 km from Hatkanangale. 331km from state capital Mumbai. Padali Pin code is 416212 and postal head office is Radhanagari .Ambap (2 KM), Ambapwadi (3 KM), June Pargaon (3 KM), Nave Pargaon (5 KM), Jakhale (5 KM) are the nearby Villages to Padali. Padali is surrounded by Kolhapur Taluka towards South, Panhala Taluka towards west, Valva-Islampur Taluka towards North, Karveer Taluka towards South .Vadgaon Kasba , Kolhapur , Uchgaon , Uran Islampur are the nearby Cities to Padali. Padali Local Language is Marathi. According to last census in 2011, 3481 People are living in this Village, out of these 1792 are males and 1689 are females. Population of Padali is 3,899 inhabitants in 2022. Literate people are 2463 out of 1385 are male and 1078 are female. People living in Padali depend on multiple skills, total workers are 1906 out of which men are 1068 and women are 838. Total 662 Cultivators are depended on agriculture farming out of 490 are cultivated by men and 172 are women. Padali population in 2023 is estimated to be 4,247.


