The wheel portrays the cycle of creation, preservation, and release and signifies the movement in life across time and space. The symbol thus stands for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social change.

Organization:

Most Government and government-aided institutions both schools and colleges have NSS units composing volunteers. Even private institutions are encouraged to have NSS volunteers. A unity may typically count from 20 to 40 students. They are managed internally by responsibility from a school or college that reports to the regional NSS coordinator. Most of the institutions do not incorporate a separate uniform for NSS though it can be.

Kasarwadi is a village in Kolhapur district, Maharashtra. It's in western Maharashtra and belongs to the Pune administrative region. The village is located north of Kolhapur city (15 km away), near Hatkanangale (15 km away too). Mumbai, the state capital, is much further (334 km). Kasarwadi's mail comes from the Vadgaon (Kolhapur) post office, and the pin code is 416122.

Padali (3KM), Manpadale (3KM), Sambhapur (4KM), Toap (5KM) are the nearby villages to Kasarwadi. Kasarwadi is surrounded by Kolhapur City towards south, Panhala Taluka towards west, Valva-Islampur Taluka towards North, and Karveer Taluka towards the South. Vadgaon Kasba, Uchgaon, Kolhapur, and Ichalkaranji are the nearby cities to Kasarwadi. The local language used in the village is Marathi. Kasarwadi village's total population is 2210 & number of houses are 447. Female population is 48.5%. The village literacy rate is 76.2% & Female literacy rate is 34.3%. The Government Healthcare center near Kasarwadi is Shiye, Sub center Shiye, Near Primary School.









Drawing lines on ground for Continuous Contour Trench (C. C. T.).




